ABOUT THE JUROR

Julia Galloway is a utilitarian potter and professor. She was raised in Boston, MA and began making pottery in high school inspired by a peaceful classroom pottery studio, an innate hand eye skill and a love of beautiful objects. She currently lives in Missoula, Montana. She teaches ceramics and is the Director of the School of Art. She has exhibited across the United States, Canada, and Asia. She was recently awarded a United States Artist Grant and named a Distinguished Scholar at the University of Montana. Having made pottery for the past 25 years, she has now come to understand the world through the making of objects and value labor, the love of community, and objects of beauty.
