Printmaking & Book Arts

Letterpress, paper-making, book binding, linoleum block printing, mono-printing, screen printing. Also curriculum-specific options such as a hands-on workshop referencing Frederick Douglass and James Vick and their use of printmaking technology as a communication tool toward profound historic impacts beyond their native Rochester.

Ceramics

Handbuilding workshops and classes are available for all ages, and can be tailored to fit dozens of curriculum-specific arts experiences from ancient Greek vases to cuneiform tablets. Wheel throwing classes are offered for ages 9 and up, and demonstrations can be given by our artists-in-residence to any age.

Photography & Digital Arts

Digital and film-based photography, lighting studio, darkroom facilities, cyanotype, pinhole, animation, Adobe Creative Suite, and more. Students learn composition techniques, equipment processes and how to edit the photograph.
