



STUDIO 678 RCSD TEACHER ADVISORS

The Photography & Digital Arts Department of Flower City Arts Center, 713 Monroe Ave., is in need of Teacher Advisors who currently work in the Rochester City School District for our 2023-2024 after-school photography and writing program. Our students are 6th, 7th and 8th grade students who attend any school in the Rochester City School District.

Program Goals:

- Empower youth to express their vision and voice
- Enable youth to build life skills
- Encourage youth to connect with the community, through field trips
- Enhance knowledge of school subjects, through practical application
- Energize youth to work together in groups
- Establish mentoring relationships

We are looking for RCSD Teacher Advisors on Wednesdays and Thursdays to provide an essential link between the structure of the school day and the structure of Studio 678. RCSD Teacher Advisors typically work with the same group of 5 students, alongside a Lead Photography Teacher, throughout the program but must be flexible to help with other groups as needed. RCSD Teacher Advisors will report on either Wednesday OR Thursday for 35 teaching sessions from September 13th, 2023 - May 22nd, 2024 OR September 14th, 2023 - May 23rd, 2024. Attendance is also required for a few Saturday field trips, a few training sessions before and during the program, hanging the student's artwork at The Link Gallery in City Hall in May, along with the program's culminating Awards Ceremony, Book Release, and Exhibition Reception at The Link Gallery; dates TBD.

RCSD Teach Advisors Must:

- Be currently employed by the Rochester City School District
- Be willing to establish mentoring relationships
- Be able to commit to ALL meetings and be consistently available via phone or email
- Helpful skills that are NOT expected include knowledge of film photography and darkroom printing, studio lighting, matting & framing, creative writing, Photoshop and InDesign

RCSD Teacher Advisors are paid as independent contractors on a bi-weekly schedule at \$20/hour for roughly 4 hours a week (depending on their schools dismissal time).
